Grammatical features of Philippine and Japanese Englishes: A corpus-based analysis

Shirley N. Dita is Associate Professor and Chair at the Department of English and Applied Linguistics (DEAL), Br. Andrew Gonzalez FSC College of Education, De La Salle University, the Philippines. She was the Director of the Lasallian Institute for Development and Educational Research (LIDER) for six years before her appointment as DEAL Chair.

Dr Dita considers World Englishes, Corpus Linguistics, and Austronesian Linguistics as her areas of interest. She has given various lectures, workshops, themed panels, and webinars on these topics. She mentors PhD and MA students and likewise publishes topics around these areas.

She has held various key positions in local and international organizations such as being the President of the Linguistic Society of the Philippines (LSP). Likewise, she was the 2020 Chair Holder of the Br. Andrew Gonzalez FSC Distinguished Professorial Chair in Linguistics and Language Education.
