Edgar W. Schneider is Emeritus Professor of English Linguistics at the University of Regensburg, Germany, and was Senior Visiting Fellow at the National University of Singapore from 2021 to 2023. He is an internationally renowned sociolinguist, known best for his "Dynamic Model" in World Englishes research (Postcolonial English, CUP 2007). He has published many books (including *English Around the World*, CUP, 2nd ed. 2020) and articles, lectured on all continents, including many keynote lectures, and reviewed for many international universities, publishers, and institutions. He edited the journal *English World-Wide* for many years and was President of the International Society for the Linguistics of English.
